What is Feng Shui?

- 1. Feng Shui in Chinese means Wind and Water. Ancient Chinese Imperial Government in consultations with Feng Shui grandmasters invented these two words to logically explain an ideal place to locate a building and how the design and structures of a house or building and the inside and outside environmental factors affecting the harmony, wellbeing and health issues, empowerment and prosperity of its occupants.
- 1.1 In brief term: Feng Shui is the ideal placement of a house/building in a harmonic location with harmonic design to enhance and receive the highest negatively ionized fresh air to support the wellness and vitality of occupants to support their performance and enhance success in their life aspirations!
- 1.2 Feng Shui practice is generally grouped under the following categories as each category has their own uniqueness and need special treatments and rules. For instance, a chief minister office, a prime minister office and a company ceo office each requires its unique supporting design, features and structures. A

- 1.3 house for a normal businessman will be very different from a chief minister's house.
- 1.3.1 Government buildings Feng Shui; house and apartment Feng Shui; business buildings Feng Shui; shopping malls Feng Shui; academics(schools and universities) Feng Shui; Scientific research Feng Shui; factory Feng Shui; hotels and hospitality Facilities Feng Shui; hospital and health clinics Feng Shui; gardens and landscape Feng Shui ; cities and township Feng Shui; facilities for animals Feng Shui; grave yard Feng Shui etc;

1.3 Asians, especially traditional Chinese families often associate a good Feng Shui house or commercial building will bring in good fortune, empowerment, lots of abundance and wealth for the families. Successful and rich Asians desire to increase and sustain their prosperity and wealth would seek the service of experience Feng Shui masters or consultants to locate good Feng Shui land sites and to work closely with their architects to design and build good Feng Shui design houses and business buildings;

2. Feng Shui Practice Is Logical & Scientific

2.1 Many modern Feng Shui researchers in Malaysia, Singapore and Hong Kong are now able to logically and scientifically prove and explain why a house or a commercial building with certain design features in certain location would prosper and which house/building would cause hardship and loss of wealth to occupants. They look at the environmental factors, landscape, location, design of the building and where the main door is facing. Feng Shui experts and senior Feng Shui masters are also able to look at the environmental factors in a housing and commercial project and by looking at the development plan and the design of the houses/building to predict the success or failure of a project or part of a project and which of the houses and business buildings in the project would be unhealthy to live/work in or would experience higher incidence of financial and business problems;

2.2 Senior Qi-Mag Feng Shui consultants from the Qi-Mag International Feng Shui and Geobiology Institute/College(www.qi-mag.com) who are also specialists in building biology are able to identify geopathic and EMF stress factors in a house/building and can quite accurately predict the health outcome of occupants in a house or business success/failure in a building. For example when geopathic stress fields are found under sleeping areas, there is a higher incidence of cancers and degenerative diseases and heart diseases.

3. Near Clean Calm Waters is Good Feng Shui

3.1 Citizens around the world are looking for homes that are near and facing waters(the Water Factor in Feng Shui) like lakes, quite calm harbour and waterfront houses in a bay or lagoon. Houses in such locations often command the highest premium prices. Why these silly people spent several times more to buy these houses? Because these successful citizens intuitively know that homes facing calm waters have good vital and feeling good energy (Feng Shui) that can support their life aspirations! Women generally are more intuitive and have good feeling when asked to select the most harmonious house to live in!

3.2 Geomancy and Feng Shui scientists supported by sensitive modern equipment found that homes or business buildings near water locations have the highest negative ionized fresh air high in oxygen and natural nutrients which supports excellent human health and vitality. People living in such locations have higher vitality, better mental clarity and able to do and work smarter thereby enhancing their ability to earn more money and accumulate more wealth!

3.3 Facing Big Open Space & Good City Views is Good Feng Shui

3.4 Second tier good locations to live are houses facing a large open space like a green park or built on higher ground with views of city or town. The old Taoist saying "what you can see you can get!" philosophy. Houses facing a green park also attract higher than average negatively ionized air. When you have a city view you can interact with city citizens and advance yourself in job opportunities, careers and have opportunity dealing in business. 3.5 Skeptical persons often challenge why so many super rich persons without knowledge of Feng Shui are able to become multimillionaires and billionaires? Super rich persons around the world even without the knowledge of Feng Shui BUT they have very good intuition and sensitive feeling able to select good Feng Shui homes and office buildings that have good environmental factors to support and enhance their success and wealth creation. We found the homes and business buildings of most rich or super rich persons have many good Feng Shui qualities and factors!

3.6 One can easily deduces and note that all major rich cities around the world are built next to waters, for example New York, London, Shanghai, Hong Kong, Singapore, Sydney, Melbourne, Perth, Brisbane, Auckland, San Francisco, Los Angeles, Boston, Houston, Chicago, Toronto, Vancouver, Hamburg, Istanbul, Mumbai, Seattle, Rio de Janeiro etc. Those cities that are sheltered from strong sea waves and winds and built in calm bays are usually more prosperous and their citizens are also more healthy, happy and successful;

3.7 One of the major Feng Shui factors (the Wind factor in Feng Shui) is to avoid living in areas where there are strong winds blowing the whole day or locate a house on top of a hill which is subject to continuous strong wind flows. People living in areas with continuous daily strong winds blowing tend to suffer from more health problems and have severe winkles on their face and exposed body parts.

4. Placement of a House on Land

4.1 Preferably the front of a house should have a big open space in Feng Shui called "Mingtang" meaning big bright open space with a width of at least one third the length of the house and preferably facing water features. For flats or condominium units, each unit must have a balcony or a terrace in front and the balcony/terrace becomes the front door area like a "Mingtang" for high vitality living qi to come into the flat. Flats and condominium units without balcony and terrace also lack vital qi and is like living in an enclosed prison lacking freedom and motivation to succeed in life. It is a well proven fact that citizens living in flats and condominium units without any balcony and terrace are less successful in life than those living in units with a balcony! It is common knowledge worldwide that flats or condominium units with balconies are fetching higher values and capital appreciations are also much better;

5. House Design Determines Ability of Family To be Successful in Life and able to Hold on To Wealth

5.1 Listed below are a few common Feng Shui taboos and bad house/flat design problems that have caused countless humans sufferings and health problems.

5.1.1 The Shape of a House or Flat

5.1.1.1 In Feng Shui practice, a house/flat is divided into three sections from the main entrance to the

back of the house/flat to provide opportunity for three generations to live and grow. The first section next to the entrance door is for the parents, second inner section is for children. The last inner most section at the back is for the grandchildren. If the width of a house/flat is narrow looking in from the main entrance to the back, then this house/flat cannot support the growth and prosperity of a family for a longer time. A long rectangle shape house/flat is preferred.

5.4 The shape of a house/flat from the front main entrance to the back should be of equal width or preferably the back end one third is slightly bigger BUT never narrower than the front section. Narrowing width at the back means that future generations have reduced growth and prosperity.

6. Main Entrance and View Obstructions

6.1 The main entrance like our mouth must be in the middle part at the front wall of a house/flat and must be bigger and wider than the back door. If the back door is wider than the family outflow of money is higher than earnings.

6.2 Standing at the main entrance door a person should be able to have a 180 degree clear view of the street in front. Any permanent structure blockage like a car park on the left or right or worst in front of the main door will create opportunity blockages and reduce opportunity and prosperity to the family; 6.3 Standing at the main door a person should also be able to see the sky above. Unable to see the sky means there is no "Heaven's Luck" - this is interpreted to mean the family members especially the breadwinners will not be able to attract large projects or attract high salary work or job.

7. Back of the House/Flat

7.1 The back of the house/flat represents the BACK support of the family. A house/flat with the back wall all of glass or with over 50% glass or windows especially in the middle part will lack the backing to hold onto good permanent jobs or for businessmen to sustain their continuous business success and would also lose wealth. Occupants especially the lady of the house who spends more time in the house/flat also tends to have stiff back or back pains and weak kidneys and shorter lifespan.

8 Main Door and Back Door Alignment

8.1 The main door and the back door of a house/flat should not be in a straight line through. Or from the main entrance you can see the windows at the back of the house/flat. A house/flat with such a see through feature the house/flat will not be able to hold on to living vitality qi to move around the whole house/flat. Occupants in such a house/flat tend to lack vitality and unable to hold to their prosperity and wealth as well. It is likened to a person who has diarrhea immediate after eating food!

9. Feng Shui Consultation Imperative

9.1 We discovered that majority of citizens suffering from degenerative diseases like cancers, arthritic conditions and suffered from business failures, the prime cause has been found to be due to bad Feng Shui conditions in their homes, especially in their bedrooms and/or in their business premises.

9.1 Above few Feng Shui tips are part of over 2,000 Feng Shui factors to consider and identify or use as guidelines to build or to find a low stress, harmonic and high negatively ionized qi and vitality home to live or a commercial building to do your business to support and enhance your success and sustained prosperity. Aspiring to live a high quality healthy and happy life style, it is imperative to consider a small investment to engage the service of a reputable Feng Shui master/consultant who also has a good knowledge of building biology and geopathic stress factors to do an audit of your house/building or new building plan before you build your lifetime sweet home/business premises to support and enhance your success and prosperity and continue success. A Feng Shui consultation usually costs around 2-3 % of the cost of a house or office building depending on the dept of your requested services.
